
CAWD Upper Rancho Cañada Pipeline Replacement Project July thru August 2021

What, Where, When, Who, Why & How

- Replacing the existing sewer line from Via Mallorca to Via Petra and onto Palo Corona Park utilizing Pipe Bursting to minimize impacts to neighborhood.
- Line is past it's useful life and needs to be replaced.
- Work to be done by Graniterock and their subcontractor Mocon.

What, Where, When, Who, Why & How (Continued)

- Construction Preparation including video inspection of properties and of sewer line July 1st through July 9th
- Excavation of pits & pot holing to start at Via Petra week of July 12th.
- Pipe bursting at Via Petra to start week of July 19th

What to Expect During Construction

- A door hanger at your home 2 days prior to working on a pipeline that may require service stoppage to connect your sewer lateral.
- Up to 3 days of inconvenience due to pipe bursting activities at a manhole near your home
- Up to 4 weeks of daytime construction activity for this portion of the pipeline work
- Sewer odors and low level noise due to equipment

What to Expect During Construction (Continued)

- Maximum of 4 hours needed to connect your lateral.
- Excavations will stay within the sewer easement & will be trench plated at the end of the work day
- If needed, there may be a sewer bypass hose running through the property to the downstream manhole.
- Traffic Control will allow access to your homes.




